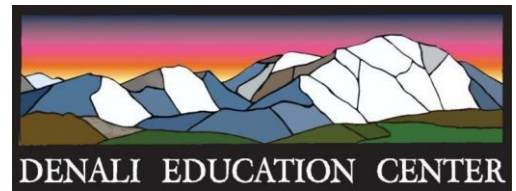


Denali Discovery Camp Instructor-In-Training

Position Description

Job Duration: June 12-14 (Training), 17-21, 24-28

Overview:

Denali Discovery Camp is a week-long environmental education program offered in partnership with the National Park Service through the Murie Science and Learning Center. The program's goal is for youth entering grades 1-8 to explore Denali National Park in a fun and safe manner. We are looking for enthusiastic high school students, or college aged students with an interest in outdoor education, to serve as Instructors-In-Training.

This position is a great opportunity to stay involved with Denali Discovery Camp after being a camper and puts you on track to become a full instructor after high school. You will gain meaningful leadership experience while putting the skills you have developed into practice daily. Become a role model for younger campers!

Position Responsibilities:

Instructors-In-Training will assist Instructors and NPS Rangers with leading educational hikes, engaging hands-on learning activities, and leading an overnight camping trip in Denali National Park. Regular duties include:

- Work collaboratively with two lead camp instructors to co-teach and co-supervise up to 10 youth in an outdoor setting for at least seven hours per day, five days in a row, for two consecutive weeks.
- Help campers to explore and connect with the natural world around them by assisting with facilitating hands-on environmental learning activities that are educational, fun, age-appropriate, safe, and promote and adhere to Leave No Trace principles.
- Follow and enforce risk-management protocols as outlined by NPS, DEC, and State and Federal agencies.

Qualifications:

- Must be 16 or older for full time role. There may be part-time options for 14- and 15-year-olds.
- Enthusiasm for exploring the outdoors and working with children.
- A positive attitude and desire to learn from and work collaboratively with lead instructors.
- Current CPR/First Aid certification (Wilderness First Responder or Wilderness First Aid preferred) or ability to obtain is required.

Preferred Knowledge and Skills

- Familiarity with Denali National Park and the surrounding area
- Previous experience with Denali Discovery Camp as a camper
- Experience caring for and/or teaching children

Benefits:

Salary is dependent on experience and length of availability. Salary starts at \$400/week.
